I am excited that your child is thinking about enrolling in our AWANA clubs. Thank you for your continued commitment in bringing your Child to AWANA clubs. I know that your child will grow both physically and spiritually as he/she participates each week.

We need a registration and medical release form filled out for each child, but only one order form is needed per family. This order form will include your handbooks, uniforms, handbags (optional) and pay dues. After payment is made your child's uniform, handbook and bag (optional) will be ordered.

The AWANA handbook is used on a weekly basis to progress through the various achievements to earn awards. We use the NIV version. I know that your child will enjoy your assistance in working on their memory verses and weekly achievements found in their handbooks. Please be sure and put your child's name in their book when they receive it, so if it accidentally gets left behind, we know who to return it to. We have "ON TRACK" awards that will be given at the end of each quarter. Each child works on the book at his/her own pace but we do have a schedule to follow so they will finish their book in May. If they are "ON TRACK" in May they will be invited to a special party. The most important thing is that your child learns about Jesus and hides His word in their heart. So we hope everyone is able to finish his/her book. The AWANA uniform is an important part of our club as well, as it is used to display your child's awards as he works through the AWANA club.
